

Introducing Point Noire to our African Route Network

In line with our strategy of expanding SAA's presence in Central Africa we will introduce a service to Pointe Noire in the Congo, effective 26 January 2012.

This welcome addition to the airline's ever-expanding route network on the continent offers our customers further access into Central Africa. SAA will operate to 21 cities on the continent with the commencement of this service.

Pointe Noire, the economic capital of the Congo, is SAA's fourth new destination on the continent this financial year (2011-2012), joining Ndola (Zambia), Kigali (Rwanda) and Bujumbura (Burundi) as the airline's most recent additions to its expansive route network in Africa.

Pointe Noire is also the second-largest city in the Congo, after the capital - Brazzaville, and the main commercial centre of the country. Pointe Noire is the centre of the oil industry in the Congo, which is one of the main oil-producers in Central Africa.

Our first flight to Pointe Noire departs from Johannesburg on **Thursday 26 January 2012** to arrive at the Agostinho Neto Airport, one of the busiest international airports in the country, on the same day at 13h05.

Pointe Noire will be served twice a week, with a narrow body aircraft, the Airbus A319. These aircraft offer 120 seats - 95 Economy and 25 in Business Class.
